



Applying for 4 year old Pre-kindergarten Programs

Your 4-year old child may be eligible to attend Governor Easley's More at Four Program, Head Start, and/or Title 1 to prepare at-risk 4 year olds for kindergarten. There are two ways to apply:

- 1) You may call **919-403-6950** ext. 6852 beginning 02/19/2008 to set an appointment time between Feb. 25 and March 28, 2008. Title 1 applications must be completed by March 28, 2008.
- 2) Come by the Head Start offices at 215 Seminary St., Durham, NC (across from McDonald's and the YMCA) beginning Feb. 25, 2008. A Family Counselor will assist parents in filling out the application.

Children must be 4 years old by August 31, 2008 (born between October 17, 2003 and August 31, 2004) to be eligible for pre-k programs (4 year old programs).

Required Materials Needed from Parents for Screening:

- Proof of residency (current)
- Copy of child's Birth Certificate or medical records showing date of birth
- Copy of child's Social Security Card, immigration number or other ID number as applicable.
- Copies of all household members Social Security Cards.
- Proof of **all** annual household income (according to family size)
- If the parent/parents are students, proof of school enrollment will be necessary.
- Proof of chronic health conditions, if applicable
- Proof of IEP, if applicable
- Current child immunization records and physical (or well-child check up records)



Please Remember: Applications will not be processed without all necessary documentation.
