Pre-kindergarten Programs

Your 4-year-old child may be eligible to attend Durham County's More at Four Program, Head Start, and/or Durham Public Schools to prepare at-risk 4-year-olds for kindergarten.



There are two ways to apply:

- 1) You may call **919-403-6950 ext. 6852** beginning February 18, 2009 to set an appointment time between Feb. 23 and April 2, 2009.
- 2) Come by the Head Start offices at 215 Seminary St., Durham, NC. (across from McDonald's and the YMCA) beginning Feb. 23, 2009. A family counselor will assist parents in filling out the application.

Children must be 4 years old by August 31, 2009 (born between September 1, 2004 and August 31, 2005) to be eligible for pre-k programs.

Required materials needed from parents for application:

- Copy of child's birth certificate.
- Copy of child's social security card, immigration number or other ID number as applicable.
- Current child immunization records.
- Proof of child's chronic health conditions, if applicable.
- Proof of IEP (Individualized Education Plan), if applicable.
- Proof of address in Durham County.
- All household members' social security numbers, immigration numbers or other ID numbers as applicable.
- Proof of all household income.
- If the parent/parents are students, proof of school enrollment, scholarship awards and grants.

Please remember: applications will not be processed without necessary documentation.
